Besides the muscle and nervous functions, magnesium is part of several of the body's enzymes and is needed for the body's biochemical functions. Magnesium is a popular supplement to horses perceived as tense, both muscular and mentally. Trikem's Magnesium is highly concentrated and easy absorbed, as well as palatable and easy to dose.

It means the horse's sweat contains more salts and minerals relative to fluid. If we don't replace those minerals and salts after the horse's been sweating, its muscles and body will need extra long time to recover. This is why you should provide electrolytes after every training where the horse sweats!

Gastrointestinal



Gastro

Gastro contains lecithin a substance that forms a protective barrier between the sensitive stomach and the acidic gastric juice. Like a gut conditioner for the sensitive individual!

How does it work? Lecithin is an endogenous substance already found in the equine stomach. When lecithin gets in contact with the gastric acid it breaks down into phospholipids, required to repair the mucous membrane in the stomach. Gastro can be given as a supplement to horses with a history of gastric problems. Gastro can be given as a daily supplement or prior and during intensive periods of eg. travel and competition.



Gastric acid

The equine stomach produces gastric acid around the clock, around 35 liters every 24 hours. Put that in comparison, to the fact that a horse's stomach only contains 10-14 liters!

Horses are designed to graze fibrous food several hours per day, not being without food for more than two hours, meaning the gastric acid is needed continuously. In our modern horse keeping, where horses are left to chew very few hours of the day, this turns into a challenge and problems such as gastric ulcers become a risk.



Paraffin Oil

Prebiotics, Probiotics and Synbiotics – what's the difference?

Prebiotics are fibers and natural sugars which the microorganisms in the equine colon use as a source of nutrition. Prebiotics are suitable for horses with irregular and loose droppings.

Probiotics are living microorganisms which, when supplied in sufficient amounts, have a favorable health effect. They stimulate the healthy microflora in the equine gastrointestinal system in order to recreate a balanced microflora. Probiotics are

suitable for horses with an irritable colon, acid faeces or during longer travel.

Synbiotics is the term for supplements containing both prebiotics and probiotics. Synbiotics are suitable for horses with problems keeping body condition, reoccurring mud fever or a impaired immune system.

Muscle supplements



Muscle Maker

The perfect supplement for horses that needs to reach and maintain top shape. The combination of spirulina and BCAA makes Muscle Maker unique on the market.

Affect the horse's muscle building

A horse has circa 700 different muscles which make up almost 60% of the horse's weight. The longest muscle is called Longissimus dorsi and runs from the horse's neck all the way to the croup. Correct nutrition is required for best possible function and muscle building. The muscles needs protein, energy, minerals and vitamins to work correctly. Protein consists of amino acids, there is both essential and non-essential. The body can not itself produce essential amino acids and these we must provide the horse with via the feed. Both Muscle Maker and BCAA has a high concentration of essential amino acids.

Liniment



Competition Gel

Competition Gel is a highly appreciated liniment with no withdrawal time, actively used by many high profile stables throughout all disciplines. Use it during massage for added effect on muscles and joints, both before and after work. As a double-acting liniment, Competition Gel initially adds a cooling effect, which transforms into a longterm comfortable warmth for the horse's muscles.

Before work: Massage the muscles, ligaments and joints. The added blood flow will prepare the body for upcoming work.

After work: Massage affected muscles and joints to support recovery. The initial cooling effect will reduce potential damage in the muscle cells. The following warmth stimulates increased blood flow and improved export of waste products from the muscle cells.

Arnica Gel

How to use liniment?

A double-acting liniment is preferably used before work to help increase the blood flow. A great tip is to put liquid liniment in a spray bottle and spray on your horse. After work massage the muscles with either a double-acting liniment or a natural gel such as Arnica Gel. The massage induces the blood flow and can contribute to recovery. Cooling is used after hard work in order to reduce possible inflammation in exposed tissue.

Temperament & Boost



Focus

Help your horse regain focus and concentration. Focus is an appreciated supplement to create harmony and balance when needed, in everyday life or at competitions.

Focus contains magnesium, thiamine and tryptophan which all are needed to balance and help the horse to quicker regain focus and concentration. Focus can be given as a daily supplement and in association to situations that are expected to affect the horse such as travel, competition and change of environment.

What is MCT Oil?

MCT is short for Medium Chain Triglycerides, meaning oil chains shorter than those found in "regular" oils. The advantage of MCT oil is that it is more easily absorbed by the body's cells and transforms quickly to usable energy. Since MCT oil is accessed faster and more efficiently than other oils the horse gets a quick energy boost.

Joints



Hyaluron 100

Trikem's most popular joint supplement. Hyaluron 100 is used by professional riders throughout all disciplines and trainers within both trotting and horse racing with great results.

Hyaluron 100 contains high molecular hyaluronic acid, needed for the quality and shock absorption of the joint fluid. Hyaluron 100 is recommended both for the older, stiffer horse and for the young, growing horse to secure a long and healthy career.

What is collagen?

Collagen is a group of various proteins. Today there are 28 identified different collagens, but the ones we know most about are collagens 1-4. Collagen is the most commonly existing protein in the equine body and also in the joints. Collagen is in other words a crucial component for the joint to function correctly.

When collagen enters the body it breaks down into peptides which are transported to the part of the body that is most in need. Collagen is used for instance for producing cartilage, tendons and ligaments. Hydrolyzed collagen is already broken-down to collagen peptides and supplies the horse with complete building blocks necessary for joints, ligaments and tendons.

Hooves



Hoof

Reduced hoof quality is a concern for many horse owners. Common problems such as cracked hoof walls, fragile hooves or slow-growing hooves can be helped with a well-balanced feed ration, good hoof care and a complete hoof supplement.

To achieve strong, healthy hooves that won't crack or crumble, the hoof wall needs nutrition. Hoof contains a unique mix of biotin, silicon, zinc and amino acids which are important building blocks for the hoof's horn.

The hoof wall should be hard, elastic and among many other things contribute to shock absorption when the horse moves. Inside the hard hoof's wall is soft tissue filled with blood vessels. Thanks to the strong blood supply we may affect the hoof quality through the horse's feed. Along with regular and good hoof care, a complete feed ration gives the right conditions for a strong and functional hoof.

How do you take care of your equipment?

Traditionally equestrian equipment is made of leather, a durable natural material that ages with style through proper care. By caring for your equipment you not only prolong its longevity but also its durability which is important for safety, since dry leather cracks easily. Today, equipment made of so called vegan leather is becoming more common. Our Leather Cleaner can be used on both organic and synthetic materials.

Our top tips for equipment care are:

- Wipe the equipment with Leather Cleaner, Leather Balm, Glycerin Soap or Leather Cream after each use
- When needed lubricate the leather with Leather Oil. Preferably often with a small amount rather than rarely and richly in order to not saturate the leather
- Let it dry in room temperature, never over a radiator since that may cause to dry out the leather
