Protein Complex

Protein Complex is a protein supplement that quickly and effectively balances the protein content in your horse's ration. Protein Complex is based on Swedish dried wheat stillage and contains 300 grams of digestible crude protein per kilogram of feed. Thanks to its low sugar and starch content, it is suitable for all types of horses.

The protein content in different roughages can vary significantly. Common to all horses is that they need to consume a certain proportion of protein to maintain their musculature. Protein Complex quickly and effectively balances a ration based on low-protein roughage. Protein Complex is also ideally given to horses with increased protein needs, such as growing young horses, performance horses, older horses, or lactating mares.

With added Lysine, Protein Complex maintains a high-quality amino acid profile, which is one of the success factors for horses responding quickly to the product. The results clearly speak for themselves.

What is dried wheat stillage?

Wheat stillage is a by-product of ethanol production that is utilized for its beneficial properties for our horses. Sugar and starch are extracted from the wheat through a fermentation process and used for alcohol, leaving behind a fiber- and protein-rich mass known as wheat stillage. The wheat stillage is dried and used as a protein-rich animal feed. Thanks to the fermentation process it undergoes, the wheat stillage is naturally prebiotic, loaded with beneficial bacteria for your horse's gastrointestinal tract. We take advantage of this in several of our supplements to optimize nutrient absorption.

Minerals



Magnesium

Our highly concentrated magnesium supplement is formulated for tense horses. Magnesium is a crucial macro-mineral that is essential for the horse's nervous system and muscle function.

In addition to its role in muscle and nerve functions, magnesium is involved in the majority of the body's enzymatic processes and is needed for biochemical functions. Magnesium is a popular supplement for horses that experience muscle tension, both physically and mentally. Trikem's Magnesium is highly concentrated, ensuring optimal absorption while being palatable and easy to administer.

Magnesium

Vitamins



B-Vitamin

A liquid vitamin B supplement that complements the daily diet. A complete vitamin B supplement containing all eight essential types of vitamin B that horses need.

The different types of vitamin B play a crucial role and are essential for several bodily functions. Among others, they are involved in energy and protein metabolism, the nervous system, skin and coat health, and the production of red blood cells. Horses that train or compete may have an increased need for B-vitamins at times. When a horse has experienced an imbalance in the intestinal flora or has been on medication, vitamin production may have been reduced and supplementation could be needed to meet the basic requirements. This is also true during coat shedding. Trikem's B-Vitamin can be given to horses of all categories and ages.

Why are vitamins necessary for horses?

In the latter half of the 19th century, it was understood that certain diseases could be caused by an unbalanced diet and nutrient deficiencies. Researchers began to explore the foundations of vitamin science. Vitamins are essential for various functions in the body. Horses grazing on pasture obtain all the necessary vitamins through green grass, so we should only complement their diet with a mineral supplement. However, there has been a decrease in vitamin content in dried and ensiled forage. Therefore, during the winter months, we should not only supplement with minerals but also with a vitamin supplement to ensure that the horse receives all necessary nutrients.

Gastrointestinal health



Gastro

Gastro contains a high level of lecithin, which forms a protective barrier in the sensitive stomach against gastric acid. Acts like a soothing balm for the sensitive horse.

Did you know that a horse's stomach produces gastric acid around the clock, approximately 35 litres per day? Compare that to the fact that a horse's stomach can only hold between 10-14 litres. So how does Gastro work? Lecithin is a naturally occurring substance in the horse's stomach. When lecithin comes into contact with gastric acid, it breaks down into phospholipids necessary for repairing the stomach's mucous membrane. Gastro can be given to horses with stomach issues. Gastro can be given as a daily supplement or during limited periods when horses are affected by travel and competition.



Gut Balance

Prebiotics, probiotics and synbiotics – what is the difference?

Prebiotics are fibres and natural sugars that the microorganisms in the horse's hind gut utilise as a source of nutrition. Prebiotics are suitable for horses with irregular and loose stools.

Probiotics are live microorganisms that, when given in sufficient amounts, have a beneficial health effect. They stimulate the growth of beneficial bacterial populations in the horse's digestive system, restoring the balance of the gut flora.

Probiotics are suitable for horses with significant gastrointestinal disturbances, acidic stool, or during long travels.

Synbiotics refers to supplements that contain both prebiotics and probiotics. Synbiotics are suitable for horses struggling to maintain body condition, have poor coat quality, recurring scratches, or a weakened immune system.

Muscles & Recovery



Muscle Maker

Affect the horse's muscle building

The horse's body is composed of approximately 700 different muscles, accounting for nearly 60% of its weight. The longest muscle is called Longissimus dorsi and extends from the horse's neck to its croup. Proper nutrition for muscles is crucial for optimal function.

Muscles require protein, energy, minerals, and vitamins to perform at their best. Proteins are composed of amino acids, including essential and non-essential amino acids. Essential amino acids are those that cannot be naturally produced by the body, so we need to provide them to horses through their diet.

Muscle Maker, BCAA, and Protein Complex all contain a high proportion of essential amino acids.

Liniment



Competition Gel

Competition Gel is a highly regarded, drug-free liniment widely used by top stables across all disciplines. Use it for massage to provide excellent effects on muscles and joints, both before and after intense activity. As a dual-action liniment, Competition Gel initially provides a cooling sensation followed by a long-lasting pleasant warmth for your horse's muscles, tendons, and joints.

Before exerting activity: Massage the muscle areas, joints, and ligaments that the horse will strain. Increased blood flow prepares the body for hard activity.

After exertion: Massage strained muscles and joints to support recovery. The initial cooling helps reduce potential muscle cell damage. The subsequent warmth increases blood circulation and facilitates the removal of waste products from the muscle cells.

Arnica Gel

How to use liniment

A dual-action liniment is beneficial to use before exerting activity to promote blood circulation. One tip is to pour liquid liniment into a spray bottle and spray it onto your horse. After activity, muscles benefit from a soothing massage, either with a natural gel like Arnica Gel or a dual-action liniment. Massage stimulates blood circulation and aids in recovery. Cooling is used after intense workouts to reduce potential inflammation in strained tissues.

Joints

What is collagen?

Collagen is actually a group of different proteins. To date, 28 different collagens have been identified, but the ones we know most about are collagens 1-4. Collagen is the most abundant protein in a horse's body, including its joints. Collagen is, in other words, a vital component for proper joint function.

When collagen enters the body, it is broken down into peptides, which are then delivered to the parts of the body that need them the most. Collagen is used to develop cartilage, tendons, and ligaments, among other functions. Hydrolysed collagen is already broken down into collagen peptides, providing the horse with ready-to-use building blocks necessary for joints, ligaments, and tendons.

What is MCT oil?

MCT stands for Medium Chain Triglycerides and are fat chains of medium length compared to a "regular" oil that consists of long fat chains. The length of the fatty acid plays a big role when it comes to how it is absorbed and utilized by the body.

MCT oil is absorbed directly in the small intestine, converted into energy in the liver and gets into the cells more easily where it is used by the mitochondria (the cell's power plant), which gives the horse a quick and efficient energy supply for e.g. the muscles. A fantastic fuel for the body!

Hooves



Hoof

Poor hoof quality is a concern for many horse owners. Common issues such as hoof cracks, brittle hooves, or slow-growing hooves can be addressed with a well-balanced diet, proper hoof care, and a complete hoof supplement.

To achieve strong, healthy hooves that do not crack or chip, the hoof wall needs adequate nutrition. Hooves contain a unique blend of biotin, silicon, zinc, and amino acids, which are essential building blocks for hoof horn.

Our best tips for equipment care are:

- Wipe the equipment with Leather Cleaner, Leather Balm, Glycerin Soap, or Leather Cream after each use
- If needed, lubricate the leather with Leather Oil. It's preferable to use a small amount frequently rather than infrequently and in large amounts to avoid saturating the leather
- Allow the equipment to dry at room temperature, never dry it over a heater as it can dry out the leather

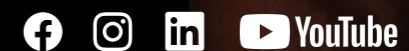
